Team Hope Christmas shoebox appeal

We will again, this year, organise collection of
shoeboxes for this appeal. A shoebox won't change
everything, but it will do far more than we could
ever imagine, by bringing Christmas to children
who have never experienced anything like it before.
Fill an average sized shoebox with gifts for a child
and drop these boxes into the parish centre Clane
(the old convent) on

Saturday November 14th from 10:00 to 3:00pm.

The boxes are then sealed and
delivered to the drop-off centre.

Cover the box in Christmas paper making sure that
you *wrap the lid and box separately.*

Decide whether your gift will be for a **BOY** or a
GIRL, and which **age category.**

Stick this label to the outside of the lid
Fill the shoe box with your gifts

Please enclose €4 in an envelope or donate online.

*Place the envelope inside the box and on the top so that
it is clearly visible when it is opened*

(Your €4 goes towards the transport, processing
and distribution costs of running the project).

Secure the lid with an elastic band, and **do not seal
the box**, as it will need to be checked to

ensure it meets customs requirements. **We always
need boxes for both boys & girls aged 10 –**

14. Please, if you so wish personalise your box
by including a Christmas card and/or photo.
