Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2025 The Annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity takes place <u>from Saturday 18 January</u> <u>until Saturday 25 January 2025</u>. This year of 2025, in addition to being a Jubilee Year based on the theme 'Pilgrims of Hope', is also the 1700th anniversary of the first Ecumenical Council of the Church, the Council of Nicaea, held in 325. That Council gave us the Nicene Creed which we profess on most Sundays and other Solemnities. Fittingly, the theme for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity this year is *"Do you believe this?"*, based on the Gospel of John 11:17-27 and Martha's confession of faith to Jesus.

The resources for this year were compiled by the ecumenical community of Bose in northern Italy. These have been tailored to more local use by the Churches Together in Britain and Ireland (CTBI), of which the Catholic Bishops' Conference is a participant through the Irish Inter-Church Meeting and the Irish Council of Churches.
