What is a Jubilee Year?

A Jubilee Year, or Holy Year, is a tradition in the Catholic Church that dates back to 1300. It is a time of spiritual renewal, prayer, and pilgrimage. During this year, the faithful are invited to deepen their relationship with God, seek reconciliation, and experience the boundless mercy of Christ.

Jubilee Years typically occur every 25 years, with extraordinary jubilees announced for special occasions.

When does it begin and end?

The Jubilee Year of Hope will begin on Christmas Eve, 24th December 2024, and conclude on the Solemnity of the Epiphany, 6th January 2026.
